Year 3

Reading: Our reading this half term will focus on our DT and Art. We will be reading non-fiction texts about Hokusai and Charles Macintosh.

Spellings: We will be continuing with the Spelling Shed scheme and extending our knowledge of prefixes, suffixes and common exception words.

Times Tables and number facts: We will be learning about the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. Please practice these regularly at home using times table rockstars.

Homework: Please ensure reading is completed a minimum four times a week. This should be noted in the children's diaries. Diaries will be checked every two weeks. Spelling homework will be set each week on Spelling Shed.

PE Kit: Year 3 will need to come to school in their PE kit every Monday and Friday.



Our area of learning this term in History will be discovering how the Persian and Greek Empire began.

In Geography we will be learning all about agriculture and the importance of the farming industry in the production and distribution of food.

In Science our focus will be on forces and magnets this half term. We will be exploring the importance of forces in our everyday lives and the difference between contact and non-contact forces.

In Art we will be using cloth, thread and paint to explore different scenes inspired by Alice Kettle and Hannah Rae.
