### Year 2

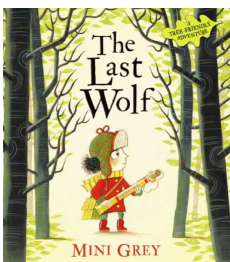
**Reading:** Children should read at least four times a week at home, and their reading diaries should be signed by an adult each time they read.
