Year 3

Reading: This term we will be reading *Stone Age Boy*, which will link to our writing in English.

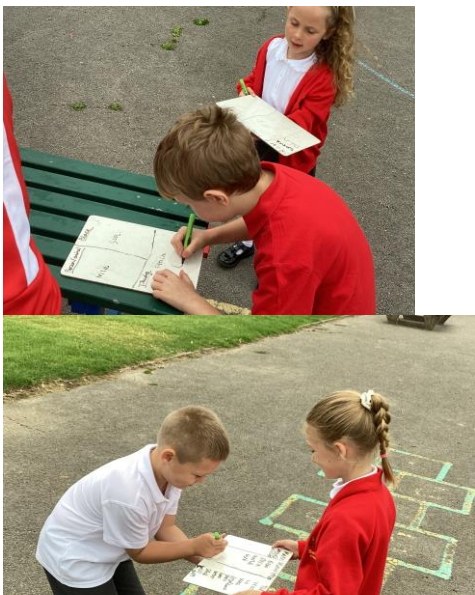
Spellings: We will be recapping the 100 and 200 high frequency words.

Times Tables and number facts: We will be recapping the 2, 5 and 10 times tables this half term. Please practice these regularly at home.

Homework: Please ensure reading is completed a minimum four times a week. This should be noted in the children's diaries.

PE Kit: Year 3 will need to come to school in their PE kit every Monday and Friday.

Our Stone Age Sleepover will be on 18th-19th November.



Our area of learning this term in History will be looking at The Stone Age and how life in Britain has changed since then.

In Geography we will be investigating The British Isles. We will be learning what makes up the British Isles and how the geography of the area has changed since The Stone Age.

In Science we will be learning about rocks and soils. We will explore the composition of the Earth, the different types of rocks and soils and how fossils are made.

In Art the children will be exploring how to express themselves through the media of charcoal.

Daily spelling practise

Practise times tables and key number facts

Supporting your child to become more independent in getting organised for school and remembering the things they need to be ready in school.
