

Curriculum Newsletter Summer 2025 Year 3

Reading: This term we will be reading Tilly Mint Tales by Berlie Doherty.

Spellings: We will be continuing with the Spelling Shed scheme and extending our knowledge of prefixes and suffixes.

Times Tables and number facts: Please practise these regularly at home using times table rockstars.

Homework: Please ensure reading is completed a minimum four times a week. This should be noted in the children's diaries. Diaries will be checked every two weeks.

Spelling homework will be set each week on Spelling Shed.

PE Kit: Year 3 will need to come to school in their PE kit every Monday and Friday.



Our focus in History in this term will be the Ancient Egyptians and civilisations and our Geography focus will be rivers. On Tuesday 17th June, we will be having an Ancient Egyptian Day and Historic Workshops will be coming in to enhance the pupils' learning.

Our topics for Science this term will be based around animals, including humans and plants. We will look at what makes a healthy diet and how our skeleton supports our bodies. Zoo2U will be visiting on Monday 19th May with a range of animals.

Our Art inspiration will come from artists who tell stories through the pieces they create and as part of our DT unit we will be making sandwiches.
