

Do you receive any of the following?

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual household income of no more than £16,190

If you can say 'yes' to any of the above you may qualify for Free School Meals, which triggers Pupil Premium funding.

Not only will your child receive free school meals if they are in KS2 (remember, all pupils in Reception, Y1 and Y2 receive Universal Free School Meals), but the school will receive £1320 additional funding per child. We can use this in a variety of ways to benefit your child and others, so even if your child still chooses to bring sandwiches, the school will receive the funding.
