

What have we been learning about this week?

Nursery

We have continued our learning about Autumn and have learned about the woodland animals that live in our countryside. We have found out that some animals hibernate during the winter. In maths we have been counting objects carefully and finding the correct numeral. In phonics we have been listening to alliterative phrases and listening for the initial sound.

Reception

This week we have been writing our letters to Santa, discovering the journey that a letter takes and then posting our own letters to Santa. In Maths we have been developing our understanding of one more and one less using a variety of contexts to support our understanding. We have also been practising really hard for our production.

Year 1

This week in English we have finished our story Alice in Wonderland; the children have thoroughly enjoyed this text. We have now moved onto our animated text The Clock Tower and the children had some fantastic predictions about what will happen in the story. In maths we have continued with subtraction, learning how to find the difference. In science we have explored shadows as part of our Crest awards. We have launched our history topic about old toys and the children have got homework to complete finding out about the kinds of toys their grandparents would have played with.

Year 2

This week in English we have predicted what will happen in our class text The Barnabus Project and we have used role play to explore the vocabulary used. In maths, we have been adding and subtracting using the column method. In Science, we are exploring microhabitats. In Geography, we have created our own poster save the forest posters.

Year 3

This week the children have been editing their final draft of The Street Beneath Our Street. In maths, we have been consolidating our problem solving strategies. In DT, we have been researching recyclable to design our eco friendly Christmas gift.

Year 4

This week in English we have been writing instructions to follow for Ancient Egyptian Mummification; we have been using fronted adverbials and imperative verbs. In Maths we have continued with subtraction and in the wider curriculum we have been learning about the Water Cycle in Science.

Year 5

This Week, we have been pulling our ideas together in order to write a Newspaper report. In Maths we have begun to explore area and perimeter, using the skills we have learnt over the past few weeks. In music we have analysed the mood created by the different movements in Holts's Planet's Suite before visiting the planets in Science and encouraging aliens to visit them based on their characteristics.

Year 6

In English, we have been exploring war poetry by Ted Hughes and Wilfred Owen. We have looked at the different techniques they have used and the effect this has on the reader and audience. In Maths, we have been recapping our understanding of number and applying this knowledge to solve problems about area and perimeter. In the wider curriculum, we have been investigating whether light travels in a straight line, using data loggers to measure our findings.
