All members of the school community were a credit and I would like to thank parents and carers for their understanding and support as we had to adapt to a very challenging set of circumstances. Can I take this opportunity to say thank you to all the people who sent us positive comments they were great to read and lifted our spirits so much

So as of tomorrow the schools are closed and we are offering a provision for vulnerable pupils, and the children of key workers at Whytrig Middle School we will see how that develops over the course of the next few weeks. Please do not send your child unless you really have to as the schools need to be as empty as possible.

The parents of pupils on FSM have been contacted regarding what we can do in the short term. Our aim is to set up a voucher system for those parents as soon as possible but this is not as easy as we thought it would be. As soon as we have any details we will inform the parents of those pupils. This is the target for us this week.

On Friday the government finally let us know what they are going to do re exams for this year. They have said they will use teacher prediction and other forms of evidence.
