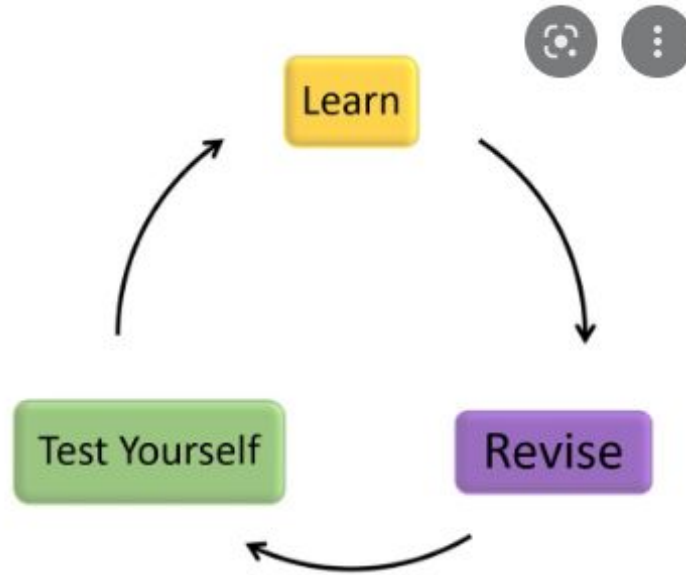

Learn, Revise, Test Yourself

This process is so important

You can't revise what you don't understand,

You can't practice what you don't know

So do not skip any of these steps



Stage 1 - Learn

- ❑ The learning process starts in school with classwork and homework
- ❑ Good Attendance is key so you do not miss out on learning
- ❑ If there is a topic you are not sure about before you start revising you could:
 1. Look back over your notes
 2. Do some research
 3. Ask your teacher for clarification



Stage 2 - Revise

- ❑ When you are happy that you understand a topic then move on to revise it
- ❑ Revising is the process of going back over what you have learnt so that you are ready to answer questions on it in the exam
- ❑ There are lots of different ways you can revise (condensing notes, mind maps, flow charts, flash cards) - we will look at each of these in the coming weeks
- ❑ Don't worry if you find something you don't understand - go back to stage one and learn it again then revise it again.



Stage 3 - Test Yourself

- ❑ To make a topic stick you need to test yourself regularly on the topic
- ❑ Start with fact recall questions
- ❑ Then move onto practice exam questions from past papers
- ❑ Use the mark schemes and examiners reports
- ❑ Build up to doing these in timed conditions as you will experience in the exam
