Start of New School Year for pupils in Year 7

We hope you have had a lovely holiday and that you and your child are looking forward to the start of the new academic year in our wonderful new school. Building work finished on schedule and the keys were handed over to Seaton Valley Federation as planned at the end of the penultimate week of the holidays. Following the bank holiday weekend, the Senior Leadership Team of both schools were able to visit the school for the first time to see the completed work, and the new school site and buildings really are very impressive. Our site staff have also been working incredibly hard over the holidays bringing over equipment, resources and furniture from the old site and getting the new building ready to go. Unfortunately, we will not be able to allow adults to enter the site beyond the staffed gate, as we will have other children on the site at this time.
