

World Book Day - Thursday 1st March 2018



We will again be celebrating World Book Day on Thursday 1st March. Our aim is to not only promote Literacy, but to promote reading and generate a love of books. We also want to celebrate the fact that 2018 is the 60th anniversary of the first Paddington Bear book being published. So we have a number of things planned. The first is that we will be encouraging the children to come dressed in a fancy dress costume relating to a **fictional** character from a book (they do not have to have read the book but they should know a little bit about who the character is and from which book they come from). Please note THIS IS NOT A NON UNIFORM DAY. The children should also bring in a reading book that they enjoy (fiction or non-fiction) for during the day D.E.A.R (Drop Everything And Read) short sessions. We also plan to have a **Book**

Swap. Children can bring in books they no longer read to swap. They will receive a Golden Ticket for every book they bring in which should be suitable for their key stage. They will then get the opportunity to choose a book (or more) by exchanging their ticket(s) with a book from the swap pile. This will be set up in our reception area with children scheduled to visit throughout the day. We have a **Where's Wally** competition planned, with Wally hidden somewhere around school, with a prize for the winner. We will also celebrate the books of **Paddington** with a quiz in the afternoon and related activities throughout the day. The Library are also running a World Book Day quiz, with all children eligible to enter.
