

Each class is timetabled for one RE lesson each week, usually with their own class teacher. Topics are sometimes introduced in an Assembly which follows a termly or half termly theme, eg 'Trust and Obedience' or 'Journeys'. These themes link to areas of the RE Syllabus, which are then taught in the classroom. The topics are organised into a two-year cycle so that each is covered once during a key stage.

Full school Assemblies take place on Mondays and Thursdays. These are taken by the Executive Headteacher, Head of School, a class or an outside speaker. The assembly on a Monday supports SMSC aspects of learning and usually covers topics relevant for that time of the year, things that have a whole school focus at that time or current affairs and topics of interest. As a school we love to celebrate success and certificates, merits and all success will be shared in our whole school assemblies. Year Groups and classes meet together regularly, usually on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon sessions.
