Zones of Regulation


At the start of this year we have introduced in ERIC once a week a programme of activities that focus on understanding the different emotions and feelings that individuals can experience on a daily basis. We are using a framework called The Zones of regulation. The four zones are:

Children are developing an understanding of the emotions that are connected to each zone:

It is hoped that children will develop further skills to be able to self-regulate their emotions by having a better understanding of how they are feeling and link it to a particular emotion in one of the four zones. They will be developing over the coming weeks their own tool box of strategies to support their own self regulation.











Over the next few weeks I will share with you the different strategies that the children are learning. This will provide you with an opportunity to discuss, with your children in the home environment, the Zones of Regulation framework language and find out about the strategies they are adding to their tool box.
