Website Revision Materials

- Make sure you have produced a revision plan: subjects and topics
- Chunk your revision time up: 30/40 minutes on a subject or topic - use the 'active revision' techniques that have been shared in lessons
- Two 'chunks' of revision a night
- Attend after school revision sessions
- Don't leave it until the day before the exam
- See staff well before any exam if you are unsure of a specific topic
- Refer to the revision guides you have
- Work hard and give it your best efforts!
