- 1. Title Page: Natural forms 3D.
- 2. A power point where on each slide you collect images from a different culture that you are interested in. You should look at minimum of 4 different cultures.
- 3. Written analysis of 3D design from your chosen culture
- 4. Practical analysis (drawing) of 3D design from your chosen culture.
- 5. Written analysis of Art from your chosen culture
- 6. Practical analysis (drawing) of Art from your chosen culture.
- 7. Written analysis of other types of design (textiles, Lettering, architecture etc) from your chosen culture focussing on patterns and textures.
- 8. Practical analysis (drawing) of other types of design (textiles, Lettering, architecture etc) from your chosen culture focussing on patterns and textures.
- 9. Research and analysis of the kinds of products you are thinking about applying elemnts of your culture from; e.g. if you want to make jewellery box which looks African you need to look at jewellery boxes.

10. Initial ideas:

This is where you draw out ideas for lots of **different products** you could make from your chose fruit form(s). you need to identify the idea you like the best.

11. Developed ideas:

This is where you draw out different ideas for **your chosen product** experimenting with details (different ideas for handles, spouts, lids stems and bases etc.

12. Final Design:

This is where you draw out your final idea for **your chosen product** in as much detail as possible and explain why you like it.
