You all took a Star Test back in January where you were asked to create a new password - I have reset them all to ABC (please do not change them) just in case anyone has forgotten it/doesn't have their diary at home.

Once logged on you should see this.



There are 2 things you can do here: take a Star Test (which determines your reading level) and you can do your quizzes.

We have set an authorisation code for the Star Tests so that you can't do one until we want you to. We do not want you to do one at the minute.

If you click on the orange Accelerated Reader icon it takes you here:



This is where you can search for a book and then take the quiz.



You need to find the correct version of the book you are reading - as you can see there are many different versions of The Wizard of Oz. Click 'Take Quiz' and then answer the questions.

When you have completed the quiz, it automatically calculates your score and logs all your scores.

Click find a new book to start reading another and it takes you back to the search bar.

Top right is an icon for Progress. Click this. This shows you how you are doing in your quizzes. As you can see, this student didn't do very well on that quiz therefore it doesn't register the amount of words read.

You can click the genres of books that interest you - this then creates lists of books you may be interested in when you access your 'library'.

Then you should see this screen. It tells you basic information about you and your reading.



The Star Score and ZPD are not linked yet - so you need to click on the orange button 'connect now'.

Next, you will be asked to log in to the Renaissance software. Enter the user name and password that you use to log in when you take a Star Reading test (see above - it is sv login and password ABC)

You will go back to myON. After a moment, the ATOS ZPD that is shown will be based on your latest Star Reading test.



If you see a message telling you that you will see your Star Reading score once you have taken a Star test, you have not yet taken a Star Reading test.

Once you see your Star Reading scores, you can select See more to see your Star Reading scores for the last two years along with the number of days with reading and the number of minutes you read. You can choose to see your ZPD, Star Reading score or Lexile scores from your Star Reading tests.



Once you have linked your 2 accounts (myOn and the Accelerated Reader) you will see suggestions of books you can read, and you can have a look at the different sections.

Click on your name (top right) and you can view:

- Progress
- Interests
- Activity
- Journal
- Portfolio
- Change your avatar
- Check your profile

Your home page counts your minutes reading, shows you any projects teachers may have set.

# Finding a book

If you want to find out if a particular book you have is within your ZPD range (Book Level), you can check here. <u>https://www.arbookfind.co.uk/</u>



Search for the book and then check the results (see below)



So as you can see, the book Saddlebottom:

- has a quiz (so when you finish reading it, you can quiz on it and it will automatically count the words you have read).

- It is BL (book level) 6.1 (so if my ZPD was between 5.9 - 6.9 I could read this)

If you know your ZPD/Book Level range and want to know which books you can read, you just can use the advanced search option. You have to select an Interest Level (so you would be MY (Middle Years) amd you have to put your ZPD/Book Level range in (So I have put in 5.9-6.9)
