# **Milestones and Learning Outcomes**

## Year 5

- Identify a range of jobs in the community and describe what people in those jobs do.
- Recognise personal strengths and interests, explaining activities they enjoy and what they are good at.
- Demonstrate an understanding of teamwork, showing how working with others can help solve problems.

# Year 6


- Explain how different jobs help society, giving examples of roles that support their community.
- Describe the importance of learning and perseverance in achieving goals, linking this to future ambitions.
- Recognise a variety of skills (e.g., creativity, communication, organisation) and identify ways to develop them.

# Year 7

- Identify personal strengths and interests and explain how they relate to a range of different careers.
- Describe a variety of jobs and careers and the skills they typically require.
- Demonstrate basic career-planning skills, such as setting simple goals and understanding how school subjects connect to future pathways.

#### Year 8

- Recognise the link between school subjects and career options, explaining at least two possible pathways linked to their interests.
- Demonstrate understanding of key employability skills, such as teamwork, communication, and problem-solving.
- Recognise different types of qualifications and routes, including academic and vocational options.
