WMS PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM (from September 2025)

In our Newsdrop on 6th June, we shared our new PE kit of a maroon and black t-shirt with the school badge on it to replace the old white t-shirt. This change applied to any child joining our school at the start of this term in Year 5 (and new starters in other year groups). The t-shirt is a modern design and reflects the school colours and will be much more practical in terms of maintaining its clean look, especially from outdoor sport. It will also be able to be worn by children representing the school in sports activities outside of school (as we no longer hold a supply of school team kit for matches/sports events for children to wear). The old black sweatshirt has also been replaced with a maroon and black mid-layer with the school badge on. We did however say that children who were in Year 5, 6 and 7 last year could continue to use the old PE kit this year, but **MUST** purchase the new regulation PE kit when they come to replace it (if they outgrow or lose items). Children representing the school for sports teams or events this year will require the new regulation PE kit. The regulation PE kit is as follows:

- Maroon/black crew T-shirt with Whytrig crest.
- Black shorts or PE skirt.
- Gym shoes/trainers/football boots with moulded studs (not blades).
- Maroon/black mid-layer with Whytrig crest.
- Black tracksuit bottoms (or black leggings purchased from school supplier).
- Black football socks.



It is essential that alternative footwear is provided for these activities. In our new school we are delighted to have access to a 3G pitch as part of our sport facilities. **Children in both schools are only permitted on to the 3G pitch wearing football boots (with screw in studs less than 21mm) or football boots with moulded studs. They will NOT be permitted on to the 3G pitch without these. Bladed football boots (boots with a wider-fin shaped form of stud)/shoes are not permitted. Please see the following information sheet which has been provided by the pitch supplier. There is a copy of this in the new Parent Information Pack (which can be found on the school website at <https://svf.org.uk/whytrig-middle-school/parent-information-pack>).**

It is essential that children have the correct footwear for the 3G pitch, as it is likely that we will not have access to the new school grass pitches until summer 2026, when the new grass has fully bedded in.

Please note, all PE Kits and belongings should be clearly marked with the child's name.
