Our books in school are colour-coded in order for students to choose their new readers easily and then when they have finished their book, they take the quiz and earn rewards!

Reading 'on the move'

Just a reminder that every student at Whytrig has their own myOn account. This is an online reading account where the children can read books online (they can even download them to their devices so they can read when they are in the car, on the bus, on the move). It is a brilliant platform for the children to use as it has many functions to support them in their reading, e.g. audio and dictionary function to check the meaning of new vocabulary. When they have finished the myOn book, they can then head straight to the AR page to take the quiz. There are many students who are making the most of this which is brilliant to see!
