Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium: 2019 to 2020

In 2019-20 the school received £3,404 in Year 7 catch up funding.

In total there were 234 pupils on roll in 2019-20 and funding is allocated to our school on the basis that we receive the same overall amount of year 7 catch-up premium funding we received in 2018 to 2019, adjusted to reflect the percentage change in the size of their year 7 cohort between the October 2018 and the October 2019 school censuses.

The money was allocated in the following ways:

- Employment of Teaching Assistants in order to deliver specialist interventions for pupils who are falling behind age related expectations.
- Staff training to ensure high quality Teaching and Learning across the school.
- Teaching Assistant support in all lowest set Maths and English groups across the school to allow focussed small group work to take place.
- Purchase of Accelerated Reader – whole school graduated reading approach.
