Year 7 Catch-up Funding Report and Expenditure Plan 2019

Context

Year 7 catch-up premium funding provides the school with additional funding to support pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of Year 6 (end Key Stage 2).

The allocation of the Year 7 Catch-up Premium for 2018 – 2019 was £15,019 The funding for 2019-2020 is expected to be £20,879

Intervention Strategies 2018-2019

To best support pupils who did not achieve age-related expectations at the end of Year 6, the funding is used to support the following strategies to improve progress and attainment:

Specialist reading and maths support (1:1 and small group interventions delivered by the Learning support Department)	£12,888
In-class TA support for reading and maths classes	
Resources to support reading interventions	£2,131

Attainment Analysis 2018-2019

Selwood uses GL Tests to provide a nationally standardised assessment of attainment and progress.

Reference is made to performance in grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) as an indication of progress in writing as this data is directly comparable to nationally standardised assessment outcomes from the GL tests.

Of the pupils who were not achieving age-related expectation at the end of year 6, the proportion of these pupils continuing to be below the expected standard has reduced in all subjects (see below).
