As you are aware, if we receive confirmation of a positive Covid test at Selwood we may be instructed to send bubbles home to isolate, you would initially receive such information via text and relevant details placed on the school website and Facebook page.

In preparation for this I would be grateful if you could let us know how you intend for your child(ren) to return home if this situation arises during a normal school day by completing the survey below:

We will then use the information you provide and contact you via text to let you know that action has been taken.

It is important that you keep us updated if any of the arrangements change please. This can be communicated by e mailing the school.

If you intend to collect your child please note that this must be asap and within 45 minutes of our message being sent out, as explained in our previous communication.

Those that travel via school/public transport **will not** be permitted to use this method to return home if isolation is required, so please consider how you will collect your child(ren) in these circumstances.

It is important to note that whilst one year group might be affected, siblings in other years may not and therefore would not be sent home.
