Harry Potter Trip – 5M, 5R, 5S

The English department at Selwood are delighted to offer pupils in Year 5 the opportunity to attend an educational session at Warner Bros studios - The Making of Harry Potter.

During the day, pupils will be given a lesson on creative writing from the team at Warner Bros Studios. This will also include the opportunity to discuss careers in the film and TV industry with professionals working at the studio.

Following their lesson, pupils will then be given a tour of the Making of Harry Potter exhibition at the studios before returning home.

The cost of the trip will be £39 which includes the cost of the day as well as the coach to and from London. Please pay on ParentPay by 31st October. This cost is non-refundable.

The trip will run on the 10th January 2024. Pupils should arrive at school for 7:45am to depart promptly at 8am. We will aim to return to the school by 6pm but will keep parents updated via email.
