Sadly, the Merlin Theatre is not able to accommodate a performance due to the health and safety measures placed upon venues. The theatre can only accommodate 30% audience capacity and the backstage conditions are not able to offer the social distancing measures required.

The children have worked so hard on the production and we are very sad that this decision has had to be taken, but I am sure you will understand that the safety of all concerned is paramount here. Please pass on our sincere appreciation for all their hard work.
