

Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Year 6 Mendip Adventure Camp

Less than one week to go until the Year 6 Mendip Adventure Camp Trip. If you have said that your child will need medication on the trip then you should have been contacted to organise a plan and for you to drop off all the medication required. If this hasn't happened, please contact the school. (Inhalers for asthma and EpiPen's are fine, your child will need to keep these on them at all times).

Below are the main points of information for the day that your child goes on the trip:

Groupings and days:

Trip 1 - Monday 6th to Wednesday 8th July - (6M, 6L, 6F & 5 pupils from 6E)

Trip 2 – Wednesday 8th to Friday 10th July – (6R, 6S, 6W and the remainder of 6E)

Day of camp:

- Wear your clothes that you will be happy to do water sports and the assault course in (These will get wet and muddy).
- Please have a day ruck sack with your packed lunch (Free School Meals will be provided for those who normally get them) drinks bottle, change of clothes (including socks and footwear), towel, coat, and a bin liner to put wet clothes in. Keep separate from your main bag.
- Arrive at school from normal time dropping bags into hall.
- Register in your tutor rooms as normal and go to Period 1.
- Period 2: Meet in the main hall – register and groupings.
- 10:45am (Mon) and 11.00am (Wed) leave on the coach for Mendip.
- 12.00pm/12.15pm arrive at the water sports centre for lunch, water sports activity and assault course.

Day of return:

- Leave Mendip at 1.00pm (Wed) and 1.15pm (Fri)
- Return to school for 2.00pm (Wed) and 2:15pm (Fri)
- Pupils can be collected at this time, please park in the football club car park and walk up to meet pupils at the bus loop. Any one not picked up will be let out at normal school ending time.

Provisional Personal Kit List – please ensure everything is named

- Small backpack (school backpacks are ideal) containing packed lunch, reusable water bottle, waterproofs and a warm jumper for the first day.
- Waterproof jacket
- Warm hat
- Gloves
- Thick jumper or fleece top
- 2 thinner jumpers/fleece tops
- 3 changes of t-shirt
- 2 pairs of old loose-fitting trousers (not jeans)
- 5 changes of underwear and socks
- 1 pair thick socks
- Pyjamas/nightwear
- Wash kit & 2 towels
- Swimming costume/trunks
- Stout outdoor trainers - be prepared for these to get wet
- Second pair of trainers to keep dry
- Wellingtons or walking boots
- Tracksuit/jogging bottoms/leggings
- Shorts
- Sun hat and sun block
- Waterproof trousers
- Bin liners and plastic bags to put wet/muddy gear in
- Water bottle (plastic, a 1 litre squash/lemonade bottle is ideal)
- Lunch box
- Warm sleeping bag
- Warm blanket
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Torch
- Reading book/puzzle book/pack of cards could be brought for the coach journey - or for use during free time on the camp
- A large soft holdall in which to carry all of the above
- Inexpensive cameras may be brought at the owner's own risk.
