**Year 6 Mendip Adventure Camp (week beginning 6th July 2026)**

As part of the enrichment programme at Selwood, all Year 6 pupils have the opportunity to take part in a Mendip Adventure Camp, which is a 3 day (2 night) residential during the week of the 6<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> of July 2026. The trip is open to all children in Year 6. The Mendip Activity Centre run and lead the camp. The personnel of this company all have recognised qualifications in the activities they are instructing. The Academy has made use of their services for several years and all previous residential trips have been a great success.

At this stage, it is not possible to give the specific timetable of activities, but based on last years trip it is likely to include abseiling, rock climbing, assault course, and a water sports activity. The group will be staying in the centres lodge (If uptake is small a tented village will be used). In addition to the Mendip Activity Centre instructors, the children will be accompanied by teachers and support staff from Selwood Academy.

The cost of the trip will be £272.48 in total, and you will be required to pay using ParentPay. A non-refundable deposit of £50 will be payable by **14<sup>th</sup> November 2025**. The remaining balance of £222.48 will be added in to ParentPay over two further instalments as below.

Please be aware that all payments are **non-refundable**.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, they may be able to use their Selwood Activity Voucher to pay towards settling the balance for the trip. However, please note that we will still need you to pay the £50 deposit first. If you plan to use the voucher, please indicate this on the google form.

The school currently purchases travel insurance through Zurich which provides a basic level of cover for all children and staff. Parents are advised to purchase their own personal accident and illness insurance if they require additional cover or are concerned.

Please note that during the visit we will be taking photographs of the children for use in our newsletter and for publicity purposes. If you do not wish your child's image to be used in this way, please ensure the school is aware of this.
