## PE changing arrangements

As you are aware, pupils have been attending school in their PE kit on the days they have PE.

After May half term, pupils will be using the changing rooms again. Therefore, they will need to bring their PE kit with them in a separate bag. Pupils will also need to change at the end of the school day to attend PE afterschool clubs. Pupils will need to be organised and it is advised they check their timetable the night before and pack their PE kit as required. Whilst a settling in period will be provided to allow pupils to adjust to the new routines and expectations, pupils who arrive without the required kit for a second time each term will be issued an afterschool detention.

Summer PE kit for both boys and girls consists of royal blue socks sports socks, royal blue shorts and either a plain white T- shirt or polo shirt. Pupils may choose to wear a rugby shirt over the top for additional warmth or comfort. Pupils are also welcome to wear garments from the new PE kit if they have already been purchased. Pupils will still be expected to have their sports trainers and 3G boots for every lesson. Please can I also remind you to ensure all PE kit is named so it can be quickly returned to its owner if misplaced.

In recent years the PE department have taken great pride in attending sporting events where Selwood pupils have been the smartest school in attendance, often receiving positive comments from members of the public. We appreciate your full support to maintain these high standards.
