
12.30 Coach arrives at the coach parking terminal at the Porta Catania in Taormina



Day 4: Saturday 10th October 2026

- 07.45 Breakfast at accommodation and collect packed lunches
- 09.00 Coach departs for Vincenzo Bellini Catania Airport
- 10.20 Coach arrives at Vincenzo Bellini Catania Airport
- 13.20h Flight departs for London Stansted Airport
- 15.40 Flight arrives at London Stansted Airport
- 20:40 Selwood Academy ETA

Code of conduct – please read this with your child and both of you need to sign it

We want everyone to have an incredible trip so

- Be respectful and kind to everyone on the trip
- Listen carefully to all instructions
- Stay with your adult and in your group at all times
- Each day is jammed full, lights out and quiet will be insisted upon at a certain time
- The sea is to be seen not to be entered!
- Mobile phones are allowed on this trip – travel, photos etc. They will be handed into your group leader each evening before bed or at 9pm.

Coach expectations

Coach

- Sat throughout the journey
- Seat belt worn at all times
- There's a DVD player on the coach (teachers will take a few)
- Phones are allowed
- Coach has a toilet but only to be used in exceptional circumstances

Expectations at the airports and on the plane

- You will be in a group of 10/11 children and will have a group leader. You must remain in this group at all times.
- You will have free time in the airport and will be told a meeting point. You must be someone else at all times! A watch would therefore be a sensible idea.
- Check in, security, passport control and baggage reclaim you will move through with 10/11 others and your adult and follow theirs and airport staff instructions.
- Once on the plane you will sit in your allocated seat (no exceptions), put your hand luggage under the seat in front and relax

Hotel expectations

- You are only allowed in your own room
- Keep your room tidy, beds need to be made each morning (there will be the occasional inspection), there will be a prize for the tidiest room each day
- Every child is expected to be at meals and remain until dismissed
- No child is allowed on any balconies
- Lights out and sleep times must be respected
- Others maybe in the hotel so keep noise down – no shouting, running etc.

Expectations on excursions and on the beach

- Follow all instructions
- Speak to all adults and other children politely, kindly and respectfully
- Remain in sight of your group leader at all times
- Be responsible for your buddy and tell your group leader immediately if they are missing
- Mobile phones must be carried
- Phones must be charged during the day and will be handed in by 9pm at the latest
- Any negative use of phones or posting of photos onto social media is prohibited and will be dealt with immediately
- No-one is allowed in the sea – paddling and swimming are not allowed

- All aspects of safety and risk on tour are carefully monitored
