Dear Parent/Carer

Selwood Academy Paris Trip, France 2027 (including Disneyland Paris)

Selwood are excited to announce that we are running a residential trip to Paris, France in May 2027. The opportunity to attend this trip will be open to all pupils who will be in Year 7 from September 2026.

Proposed itinerary and accommodation

We are delighted to partner with PGL in running this trip. They are highly experienced in offering residential trips within the UK and Europe. We have chosen their site at the Château De Grande Romaine - <https://schoolsandgroups.pgl.co.uk/centres/chateau-de-grande-romaine>, which is located outside of Paris and within reach of our planned excursions. Our Year 5s will also have the opportunity to attend this trip to Paris.

The trip will run for 4 days (and 3 nights) between 25th May-28th May 2027

- Tuesday 25th May – Depart from school to France via coach/ferry. They will have a welcome tour, dinner and evening entertainment on the first day of arrival and evening entertainment each day.
- Wednesday 26th May – A trip to the Eiffel Tower, a walking tour to take in the wonderful sights of Paris.
- Thursday 27th May – A full day visit to Disneyland Paris.
- Friday 28th May – Travel back to England via coach/ferry (a stop-off en-route at a local French town/ hypermarket to practise their French).

Payment information

It has been estimated that the trip will cost no more than approximately £630.00. This will include travel, excursions, activities, accommodation, insurance and full board at the venue. We are providing this information early to allow you to pay over a period of time if you wish for your child to attend.

An initial non-refundable deposit of £100.00 will be required no later than 11th September 2026 to secure your place. Further non-refundable payments will be set up across the remainder of this year and early 2027 with the final balance being due for payment by the middle of February 2027.

All payments need to be paid via ParentPay. Receipt of the initial non-refundable deposit will be your confirmation that your child has a place on the trip.

The school currently purchases travel insurance through Zurich which provides a basic level of cover for all children and staff. PGL provides this package with insurance included and suggests upon confirmation of the trip details parents should also consider purchasing their own personal travel insurance, if they require additional cover.
