Portsmouth Historic Dockyard Year 6 trip.

Selwood Academy History department is running a trip to the Historic Dockyard in Portsmouth to study curriculum area the Royal Navy and the Tudor Warship the Mary Rose.

Pupils will study these topics prior to the visit and then experience the Warships, HMS Victory and the Mary Rose, first hand and pupils will complete a hands-on workshop.

The dates for the trip are as follows:

- 6F and 6R plus half of 6S Thursday 23rd May
- 6M and 6E plus half of 6S Friday 24th May
- 6S will be split and added to each day, pupils will be informed of which day in plenty of time.

We will need to leave Selwood at 8am on the morning of the trip and we will not return until 4pm, this is so we make the most of the day at the dockyard. Parents with pupils arriving at the school by bus will need to drop off their children for 8am and collect them at 4.15pm.

The cost for this trip will be £30 This includes coaches, entrance to the dockyard and the workshop. Please pay on ParentPay by 23 April. This cost is non-refundable.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals you may be able to use your Selwood Activity Voucher. Payments for curriculum related trips are purely on a voluntary basis, but it is possible that the event may not be able to take place if insufficient contributions are received.

If your child has Free School Meals please indicate on the form if you would like a packed lunch to be provided.
