Before School 'Start Active' Club:

Give your child a great start to the day!



Evidence shows that introducing elements of physical activity and play to children before school starts can engage their minds and prepare them for the day ahead.

The morning sessions will run for 60 minutes and aim to stimulate the learning experiences of your child. Children who attend will enter school alert and ready for the day, having engaged their minds and body whilst learning a host of valuable skills including:

- The importance of being punctual and well prepared for the day
- Being more alert for a day of learning within the school
- Understanding the importance of a healthy lifestyle
- Improved coordination, balance, agility and flexibility
- Appropriate and effective communication with others
- Engaging and interacting appropriately with other children
- Being given realistic challenges to achieve
- Using tactics and strategies to increase chances of success

Breakfast brain power...

We believe that it is important that children start the day with a good breakfast. Each day children will be served foods that are rich in grains, fibre and protein and low in added sugar to help boost attention span, concentration and memory.

Children will enjoy sitting down with their friends to refuel with Toast, Cereal, Milk and Juice.

Staff are seated with the children during meal times to encourage a "family" type atmosphere. At least one member of staff holds a current Food Hygiene certificate and all food and drink complies with dietary and religious requirements.

Session Details...

After School 'Play Active' Club:

The after school club is an extension of the school day. With this in mind, it has been designed to run smoothly, whilst reflecting the school's outstanding quality.



Our staff are trained to adapt each day based on particular children's needs or the weather. However, the structure and timing for each day will be consistent.

The below table shows an example of what the main planned activities could look like. The club will provide a relaxed environment to support children's learning and individual interests. Activities will be designed to be engaging and challenging for the ages and abilities of each child.

First session - Themed Arts and Crafts and Sports/Games

Second session - Arts and Crafts and Fun Activities/Cool Down Games

Arts & Crafts

Children get to be creative and improve their coordination whilst colouring, drawing and cutting.

Activities include: finger painting, origami, making paper chains, hat making and colouring in.

Sport and Games

Children get to develop their communication and leadership skills through team games. They'll be able to try sports and activities they may not have tried before.

Sports include invasion games, archery, dodgeball, cricket and athletics, to name a few.

Fun Activities and cool down games:

Individual challenges, obstacle courses, creative games,

parachute games, fun teamwork activities and more.

Signing In: Please escort your child(ren) to the signing in location and handover to our team, please only enter the venue at the correct times to ensure we are ready.

Signing Out: When collecting their child, parents must come to the hall door where a member of staff will meet them and check their ID if necessary or if a friend, relative, family member or neighbour is collecting their child, the parent will have to inform us in the morning session, via email or with a phone call. Each child will have a collection password, which will need to be quoted on collection.
