

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that we have been able to secure some Aware+ Training from Wiltshire and Bath Air Ambulance Charity. As part of our PASHE programme we aim to provide First Aid training for all our year 7 pupils at Selwood Academy. This will take place on **Friday 13th March 2026**.

Wiltshire and Bath Air Ambulance have tailored sessions to deliver vital lifesaving skills training on the school's behalf. The course content is age appropriate and includes the following elements:

- **How to make a 999 call**
- **Recovery position**
- **CPR**
- **Choking**
- **How to use a defibrillator**

Each session will last between 30- and 90-minutes dependant on the content to be delivered. It will be carried out during the school day. Each child will receive a certificate to come home with.

We recognise that children may have experience of first aid situations involving the emergency services. All topics are covered are sensitive and at an age-appropriate level. If you have any queries about the content of the training, please contact us here at school and we can pass on any queries to the Wiltshire and Bath Air Ambulance team led by Andrew Robinson.

We are asking for a contribution of **£2.00 per pupil** to take part in the training. Please make payment via ParentPay. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, they may be able to use their Selwood Activity Voucher. Please contact the Finance office for more information about this.
