3 things (behaviour)

- *walking* (when they are in school we want them to walk calmly through school)
- *listening* (one of our learning powers is concentration and we want the children to listen well to adults and each other - even if they are cross or frustrated)

'Learning Powers'

These are the things that we know will help the children make progress in their learning and we are teaching them how to become 'experts' at these things:

Participation, Concentration, Resilience, Pride Responsibility VIPs (Values Inspired Person)

Our Value that we will be focusing on over this term with the children is <u>COURAGE</u> (to have courage and strength in the face of challenges or fears and to have the courage to do the right thing)
