### Year 6 SATs

A huge well done to all those children who sat the Year 6 'SATs' (Standardised Assessment Tests) We were so proud of all the children who showed resilience and determination even though some of the questions and test papers were so hard. A big thank you to all the staff who also helped the children stay focused and on task.

They were treated to a celebration pyjama day on Friday with a special picnic as a way of saying well done.



The results will be out in July and we will let the children know how they got on once we have checked the results.

HOWEVER that is not the end of their learning. We will be continuing to teach all the subjects right up to the end of the year to get them ready for the next stage of their learning journey at High School and we will also be having a strong focus on developing their writing in particular over the next few weeks.

### **Building work**

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#### <u>3 things (behaviour)</u>

We are focusing on three key things with the children in their behaviour which are:

- **language** (no swearing or inappropriate language only kind, respectful and encouraging words). This is also when they are on-line. Please monitor their language when they are on social media or games.
- *walking* (when they are in school we want them to walk calmly through school)
- **listening** (one of our learning powers is concentration and we want the children to listen well to adults and each other even if they are cross or frustrated)

#### 'Learning Powers'

These are the things that we know will help the children make progress in their learning and we are teaching them how to become 'experts' at these things: Participation, Concentration, Resilience, Pride

#### **Responsibility VIPs (Values Inspired Person)**

We have been teaching our children all about the value of 'Responsibility'. This is all about taking responsibility for their own learning, behaviour, environment and for each other. We have many children in school who are really good at taking responsibility and I am sure lots of Dojo points and certificates will be given out over the next few weeks as we go over our value. Don't forget to learn our song called 'Responsible' (to a One Direction tune).
