MAX WHITLOCK (Gymnast and gold medal winner)

We had a Zoom call this week, with other schools, interviewing Max Whitlock and Tyler from Year 6 asked him a question about his sport.

We are VERY excited that Max will also be visiting our school on Wednesday 6th November with his wife Leah (and TV cameras) when he will be talking to the children in an assembly, answering questions and delivering a free Gymnastics session for one of our classes in school.

Max is the most successful gymnast in British history and the most successful <u>pommel</u> <u>horse</u> worker in Olympic Games history, with two gold medals and one bronze.

Year 6 Learning Review assembly

All of our Year 6 children shared with the rest of the school what they have been learning about in class this first half-term.

It was lovely seeing their enthusiasm for their learning.

They enjoyed telling us about some of the famous artists they have been studying including David Hockney, John Sargent and Paula Rogan. They read out some stories they have been writing based on the Nowhere Emporium class novel. They were able to talk about the circulatory system which they have been studying in Science and shared some facts about the Vikings and their raid on Lindisfarne.

(Slight) CHANGE TO END OF THE SCHOOL DAY

In order to meet the recommendations of the government for all children to attend school for 32.5 hours a week we are extending the school day for some classes to 3.20pm (from the current 3.15pm)

Therefore the school day will be from 8:50am to 3:20pm for Years 1 to 6 BUT it will stay at 3:15pm for Nursery and Reception, Galaxy, Apollo; NOVA class will finish slightly earlier at 3:10pm (the school day will still start at 8:50am for everyone) This will take effect from Monday 28th October

Sports galore

Fitness and well-being is an important part of what we do at Seven Stars school.

Over this last half-term we have had our multiskills club on a Monday and Wednesday, PASTA club on a Thursday and Dodgeball club on a Friday.

Further clubs and sports events will be taking place after half-term.

Healthy School and Healthy Eating

We take eating healthily really seriously at school, we discuss healthy eating with the children and encourage them to make healthy choices. We have a policy that only fruit, vegetables and suitable cereal bars can be eaten at playtimes and request that parents do not send in sweets or fizzy drinks at all.

All children are asked to bring in their own water bottles which they are encouraged to drink from regularly throughout the day. It needs to be water rather than juice.

Attendance

We are in the process of updating our attendance policy

PLEASE make sure your child is in school every day and on time

Well done to all those parents who are managing to get their children in to school on time It's been a great start to the year

BE READY, BE RESPECTFUL, BE SAFE

We have been discussing with our children what this means in class and at lunchtimes. We will be talking to them about how to 'Be Ready, Be Respectful and Be Safe' at all parts of the day (including on-line).

We are also thinking about what this means for staff and parents as well over the next few weeks.

Free School Meals – if you are eligible apply:

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

Universal Credit with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance

Child Tax Credit, **not** entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190 Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

Guarantee element of State Pension Credit Income Support

Working Tax Credit 'run on' – the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work

If your child is currently eligible for free school meals, that eligibility will be protected until Universal Credit is introduced (expected 31 March 2025) even if your circumstances change. If your child is still in education on this date, they will be eligible until they finish the phase of schooling (primary or secondary) they are in. If you have a younger child starting school in September and you are no longer eligible, they will not be protected because this would be a new claim
