A reminder of the remaining dates:

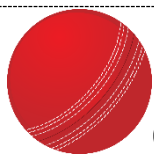
### Dates:

- **listening** (one of our learning powers is concentration and we want the children to listen well to adults and each other - even if they are cross or frustrated)

These are the things that we know will help the children make progress in their learning and we are teaching them how to become 'experts' at these things:

Participation, Concentration, Resilience, Pride

## Responsibility VIPs (Values Inspired Person)

Our Value that we will be focusing on over this term with the children is COURAGE (to have courage and strength in the face of challenges or fears and to have the courage to do the right thing)
