**All New School uniform

As mentioned this week on Class Dojo we are taking the opportunity of our new school build to review our colour scheme at Seven Stars School.

We have had red jumpers and a red design for a number of years (approximately 50 years) and so it was felt it is time for a change. We are changing from red to a much calmer green colour. Research suggests that more natural colours such as green are good for our mental health and help children to concentrate. It also reflects the focus we will have moving forward on the outdoor environment as we will have even bigger school grounds (including a wonderful fenced off science area with a pond and plantings for insects).

We will continue with the red jumpers/skirts to the end of this year and will then introduce the new green jumper/skirts/fleeces in September 2025.

Any parents who wish to continue for a bit longer with the red jumper/skirt/fleece can do so until March 2026 when we will then expect everyone to be in green.

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We will let you know about suppliers nearer the time (and you can get bottle green crew neck jumpers from most big superstores). The details of the school uniform went out on Class Dojo.

As you will see Nursery and Reception are staying the same and all other aspects of the school uniform are also staying the same.
