# New Build Arrangements for 2024

After Christmas the Shawbrook building (where Galaxy, Apollo, Moons, Rockets and After School Club currently are based) will continue to operate as usual until Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2024 and the main playground will still be open for all parents as usual.

We will then have two INSET days on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> January and Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January (for moving everything across and getting classes sorted).

On Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> January children will return to school BUT all classes will have moved out of the Shawbrook building into the one Millbrook building and the main playground will be closed. The only gate for parents to access the school grounds will be the pedestrian gate near the big field onto the back playground from 16<sup>th</sup> January. We are therefore asking if only one adult can bring children onto the school ground to reduce the amount of people coming onto a smaller area of school. Lots of schools only have one gate but we have had the luxury of a big main playground up to now.

As per the last letter that went out: Moons (Nursery) class will be in the current Year 5 class which is the room to the left of the building as you look at it from the back playground.

Rockets (Reception) class will be in the current IT suite which is the next room along (to the left of the entrance to the main hall door).

Leo (Year 5) will be in the first temporary classroom on the left as you enter the school grounds (the room nearest the pedestrian gate). Galaxy class will be in the middle temporary classroom.

Apollo class will be in the last temporary classroom nearest the playground.
All other classes will stay where they are,
After-School Club will be in the current staffroom (at the back of the main school hall).

We will send out a further letter and video on facebook / Dojo to go over the details of the arrangements.

For dropping off and picking up the children you will simply need to wait on the back playground and staff will release to you from the classes once they see you (or in the case of older children they will be sent out to you).

#### **Christmas Performances**

It has been so wonderful seeing the youngest children in our school do so well with their Christmas performances.

Rockets and Moons did an amazing job singing so loud and showing their fantastic talents during the Nursery Rhyme Nativity that was
