Phonics and Literacy

This term we will continue working on letter formation and letter

sounds using phonics shed. The children will consolidate single letter sounds in Chapter 2 and then move onto chapter 3 to learn digraphs - 2 letters that make one sound.

The children will be taught to their ability to help them continue to develop their reading and writing skills. We will continue practicing sounding out words and blending the sounds that we have learnt to read words every day! There are lots of fun games on Phonics Shed for your child to keep practicing and embedding the letter sounds (logins will be sent home), and you could join in too to listen to how we correctly pronounce the sounds!

Children will apply their phonics to word/sentence writing in Literacy. We will have many writing opportunities and enjoy many fiction and nonfiction texts that link to our topic London, beginning with **Paddington Bear**.

Reading books will be sent home that match your childs phonics level.

Please keep reading with your child at home every day. Reading books are changed on Mondays and Thursdays if they have been read at least 3 times.

Mathematics

We will be learning and exploring:

- Counting in 2s 5s and 10s
- Place value/Understanding number using equipment to make numbers up to 50/100
- Number and place value
- Measuring in CM and M
- Weighing and recording in kg and g
- Addition and Subtraction
- 2D and 3D shapes
- Multiplication using arrays
- Statistics/ tally charts
- Fractions finding halves and quarters
- Money
- Time

<u>Science</u>

Our unit this half term is Animals, including humans 1 - Growth. The children find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air) and finally will learn about the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene. After half term we will explore Living things and their habitats.
