ENGLISH-

Throughout out units of writing we will focusing on different sentence structures, consistent and correct use of punctuation and how to organise and manipulate our writing to create particular effects and engage our readers. This term, we be reading the texts The Nowhere Emporium and Beowulf. Our writing units will focus around this.

MATHS -

This term we will be concentrating on place value, written methods for calculations and mental calculations. We will also be practicing our problem solving skills every week. When solving problems, we encourage children to think through these questions: Do I know the answer? Can I solve this in my head? Do I need to do a jotting? Do I need to use a written method? Our targets for the autumn term will focus on using appropriate mental strategies

Topic

Key Questions: Who were the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons? Where did they come from? What did they believe? What was life like as an Anglo-Saxon and Viking? Where and why did the Vikings raid? Why was Alfred the Great so great? Who was Edward the Confessor?

History/Geography - The Anglo-Saxon and Viking struggle for the Kingdom of England and map work.

Art - Drawing skills and clay work linked to Dragon art.

DT - Using materials to design, cut, shape and join a Viking boat.

Science - 'Animals including humans'.

Computing - Presenting information in various ways and internet safety.
