Kindness	To be friendly, generous, considerate and caring to EVERYONE To grow in our empathic understanding of the feelings of others and care for them well. Notice when they need help and come alongside them to support, care and show kindness in our words and actions.	
Courage	To learn how to face our fears and worries, and do the right thing (no matter what). To have the courage to take part, do our best, stand up for what is right and speak up when we need to.	
Resilience	To learn how to keep going, overcoming challenges. To have a 'GROWTH MIND-SET' even when things are tough and we have setbacks. To develop strategies that help us to have mental and emotional strength to face difficult situations.	
Three Key Learning Powers		
Concentration	To learn how to focus on our learning and how to ignore distractions that might get in the way of our learning. To develop skills of listening actively in lessons and of continuing to focus on our work even if things or people around us are trying to get our attention.	
Participation	To 'have a go' in lessons and try to answer questions (even when you are not fully sure). To contribute to class and school discussions and activities putting in full effort. To volunteer in lessons to try out new things, take risks and explore the subjects being taught.	
Pride	To do and be the best we can in our learning, presentation, attitude and manners. To consider if the work we are producing is the best we are capable of and if there is any way we can improve it. To think about the presentation of our work including our handwriting.

Be Ready

To be responsible for your own learning and day by getting yourself ready or asking for help if you need someone to help you. This may include getting enough sleep, eating well, getting up on time, getting whatever uniform, equipment, clothes or items you need to be successful in the day to come.
