HELPING AT HOME

In the Moon class, we are encouraging the children to be more independent. Please continue to help your children with these skills:

- Managing clothing putting on and taking off coats, jumpers, socks, shoes. Pulling sleeves out so they can get their coat/jumper on.
- 2. Sharing stories, then let your child tell you a story.
- 3. Taking turns and being able to wait for a go.
- 4. Recognising numerals in the environment car number plates, house numbers, in the shops and at home.

MATHEMATICS

We will continue to sing number rhymes and develop our counting skills in class. We will be comparing the size and length of 2 items using a variety of vocabulary, identifying which is the biggest or which is the longest. We will be learning how to measure the length of something using multi link cubes or maths links.

TOPIC

Our topic is "Amazing Animals". We will be finding out about different animals and sorting animals in a variety of ways. We will use the terms: zoo, wild, farm, pets, insects etc. We will be learning about where animals live and the types of homes they live in, or make. We will learn new vocabulary as we describe animals and their different features. We will find out about the Lunar New Year and how it is celebrated around the world.
