We will investigate how the author of a story describes the setting and develops the characters in a story by using the books Kensuke's Kingdom and Flotsum .

NUMERACY

In year 5 we will be developing the children's basic number skills. We will learn to explain different ways in which answers can be worked out and help the children to solve problems involving addition, subtraction and multiplication, as well as solving real life problems.

Topic-Endless oceans

Our topic this term is geography based. During this topic the children will learn about life in, on and around the oceans and seas of the world. We will research various aspects of the world's oceans and look at the environmental problems that they face.
