MATHEMATICS

We are developing our number recognition and applying our number knowledge within our play. We are also developing the language of shape and starting to talk about the features of a shape eg. Sides, corners, straight, curved, flat, 2D, and 3D. We are identifying patterns and continuing patterns.

We are finding out about our locality and the wider world. We will be comparing different places and identifying similarities and differences. We will be finding out that not all families, homes and lifestyles are the same.
