New Build

A letter went out on Class Dojo on Thursday about the new build. **Please read it carefully.**

Overview (key things you need to know):

The Shawbrook car park will be closed and out of bounds from **Monday 6th November** so no parents or staff can enter the car park from Monday. **After School club** parents will need to collect children from the little door to the left of Moons class (across the Main Playground) from Monday 6th November.

Moons, Rockets, Galaxy and Apollo children will still be dropped off and collected from the same doors until 11th January.

Parking is going to be a challenge for parents and visitors at start and end of the day (please do not park in front of residents' driveways).

IF YOU ARE ABLE TO WALK OR PARK AWAY FROM THE SCHOOL that would be very helpful.

We have had to move the **INSET days** that were planned for Friday 24th November and Monday 3rd June to Friday 12th January and Monday 15th January. Meaning children will not be in school (on safety grounds) on Friday 12th January and Monday 15th January BUT WILL now be in school as usual on Friday 24th November and Monday 3rd June.

The **demolition** of the Shawbrook building will take place from 16th January 2024 (we will send a separate letter out about where the classes currently in the Shawbrook building will be learning from 16th January).

We are looking forward to welcoming CONLONs builders on-site. They will be doing everything in accordance with all Health and Safety rules putting

the safety of the children as the highest priority. We will let you know further details and give
