Welcome Back!

Well done to all of our lovely children and families who have returned this week to school and been so happy and positive.

It makes us all smile when we see the great smiles on the children and we are so proud of how hard so many of them are working. Their behaviour is brilliant and they are a credit to everyone at this challenging time.

COVID update

As you know things are changing rapidly in terms of guidance

Currently (at the time of writing) we have 11 positive cases across school which is generally good compared to many other schools and our staffing levels are still good.

As the month progresses we are expecting cases to increase but we will do all we can to keep things as normal as we can for the sake of all the children.

Please keep checking Class Dojo for messages. Any child who is off due to COVID will be set work on Class Dojo which will be very close to the kind of work they will be doing in school if they were in. Please check your child does the work so they do not fall too far behind. Please remember:

lease remember:

- wash hands frequently
- wear face coverings when in school communal areas
- keep a safe distance if at all possible
- we will continue to ventilate the school/classes as often as we can
- staff are continuing with regular testing
- if your child is ill keep them off school and do a lateral flow test (or a PCR test if it is one of the COVID symptoms)
- FROM TUESDAY 11th IF ANYONE TESTS POSITIVE WITH A LATERAL FLOW test they do NOT need to get a confirmatory PCR test but should isolate immediately

- Anyone who is a close contact of a positive COVID case person should then take Lateral Flow Tests (LFDs) for the next 7 days and isolate if any of those are positive
