We are looking at the proposal in detail and if it is agreed that we go ahead then it will not happen until September 2022 and would be a specialist unit for between 8 and 16 children. Year 6 Leavers Assembly - Wednesday 14th July 9.30am

Brilliant news. We have reassessed the situation with regard to the end of year assembly for our wonderful Year 6 children and we will be inviting parents into the school hall (under strict COVID secure arrangements) to watch one final assembly and presentation for our Year 6 children. It has been such a tough 18 months and we want the Year 6 children to have one last 'live'

celebration of all they have achieved. It will be on Wednesday 14th July at 9.30am and finish about 10.30am

However we must insist that parents/carers stick to the following strict COVID secure arrangements:

- everyone must wear a face covering (unless you are exempt)
- do NOT mingle with other adults before or after the event
- a maximum of two adults per Year 6 child and NO babies or brothers/sisters
- if you are able to do an LFD test before coming into school that would be good (if it is positive stay away and go for a PCR test - unfortunately your child would also need to stay at home)
- if you are ill in any way do not come in
- we will put chairs 1 metre+ apart please stay on our chair and do not walk around or stand up
- wait at the entrance to the school 1+ metres apart (we will stagger your entry to school and also your leaving)
- the hall will be well-ventilated (doors and windows open) and chairs wiped before and after the event
- hand sanitiser must be applied on entering the building/hall
- you can take photos/videos (sitting down) but only of your child (if you have other children on then do not post on social media)
- no other classes will join the assembly (so we have enough space) and only former teachers/staff will join the celebration at a distance

THIS WILL BE THE ONLY EVENT THIS YEAR TO WHICH PARENTS ARE INVITED INTO SCHOOL and we have adapted our risk assessment to accommodate this event for the sake of our amazing Year 6 Phoenix children.

Guidance for September

We are yet to find out about the details for arrangements for September with regards to coronavirus regulations.

We are hoping that we can return to a more normal way of doing things but once we find out from the Government and the Local Authority we will inform all parents via Class Dojo, facebook and the school web-site.

At the moment we are fairly certain that Class Bubbles will end and that we will not have to send all children in a class home if someone tests positive in their class (which is what we have to do now) There may be things that we choose to continue to do as a school such as limiting face to face meetings, maintain social distancing and staff wearing face coverings but we will confirm arrangements before we all return in September.
