Behaviour Targets

Behaviour at Seven Stars school is fantastic from the vast majority of our pupils and we are always so proud of how our children are welcoming, kind and caring to others. We realise some



children need to learn how to develop this skill but a lot of the children who struggle are making fantastic progress as they mature and develop.

We have decided to focus on three key targets with the children over the next few weeks to help them make even further progress:

LANGUAGE - being kind and respectful in what they say to others face-to-face or on-line. no inappropriate or nasty words or name-calling.

LISTEN - to listen with respect to others and especially adults, during learning or when an adult is trying to sort out a problem during play.

WALK - when indoors to walk at all times. Do not run in corridors or across the hall - to avoid accidents and make sure the school is calm.

We are inviting children to design and create a poster that encourages these three targets in our school.
