Clearly this is a difficult situation, which will cause some disruption. I would ask you, however, to be understanding. A national strike by teachers is very unusual. Taking strike action is not something that any teacher would undertake lightly. Those on strike will have thought long and hard about their decision and will also lose pay for the days that they are on strike.

School will be open as normal for all the other days of the week for all children of all classes. The attendance record of the children will not be affected as it will be classed as an exceptional circumstance.

BEHAVIOUR TARGETS

We are continuing to focus on:

LANGUAGE (being kind and respectful in what they say to others face-to-face or on-line. No inappropriate or nasty words or name-calling).

LISTEN (to listen with respect to others, and especially adults, during learning or when an adult is trying to sort out a problem during play)

WALK (when indoors to walk at all times. Do not run in corridors or across the hall - to avoid accidents and make sure the school is calm).

We are inviting children to design and create a poster that encourages these three targets in our school.

Modelling good behaviour

All adults and older siblings who enter the school premises must model good behaviour to our children at all times. That includes be careful that we use appropriate language and act in a respectful and caring way towards everyone. If there are any disputes please speak to a staff member who will ensure things are dealt with in an appropriate way. Any adults or older children who do not respect the rules and conduct of the school are likely to face a short-term ban from the school grounds which could become a permanent ban or prosecution if there is a failure to comply.

Pets

Do not bring any pets onto the school grounds. The only pets allowed will be those agreed by the school (e.g. guide dogs).
