Mobile Phones

Children are not allowed mobile phones in school. If older children do bring phones to school (e.g. because they walk home alone and you want them to be contactable) then their phones must be out of sight on the playground and then passed to their teacher when they get into school (and will be returned at the end of the day). If children do not keep to these rules they will be banned from bringing their phone into school.
