Superstars Closure

As you are aware there are still high rates of infection from the Coronavirus in the local area. A number of schools have had to close some of their class bubbles.



Unfortunately, we had to close our Early Years 'bubble' (Nursery and Reception) over the last ten days but thankfully they will be returning to us on Monday 28th June.

The classrooms have been left in quarantine so the virus will have died (which is does after 72 hours on any surface) and there has also been a thorough clean so we are looking forward to a safe return on Monday.

We are still sending children home if they are not well (especially if it is a cough, temperature or loss of taste and smell, but also headaches and general cold symptoms due to the high infection rate and wanting to protect the community.

If your child is sent home please take them for a PCR test. The rapid Lateral Flow Test is not sufficient, it needs to be the actual PCR test and anyone with suspected symptoms will not be allowed back into school until they have a negative PCR test result.

If a child or staff member in your child's class tests positive the whole class bubble will be closed and sent home where they must isolate for 10 days (a message and letter will go out via Class Dojo & email, and an initial message via text and Facebook will go out - please keep checking).

We know it is tough when this happens and puts families under a lot of strain but we always follow regulations and want to make sure everyone is safe (we have some very vulnerable family members in some of our classes).

Isolation

Please remember that if you and your family are asked to self-isolate then you and they are not allowed out in public. There is a chance of a big fine if anyone is caught in public when they should be isolating. Please do not mix with families/friends who should be self-isolating. We are trying to protect the community and we are aware of some children mixing with bubbles when they should be isolating.

Behaviour

We are so proud of the excellent behaviour of so many of our children during these very challenging times (and hot days!).

tricky when routines are a bit different and COVID has not helped with feelings of anxiety (especially for our Year 6 children) but our children are proving how brilliant they are once again!

Attendance

We have had a review of our attendance figures this week and whilst we appreciate that a vast number of absences will be beyond your control due to the Covid pandemic, we have noticed that we are having a large proportion of one day absences on a Friday which was highlighted in our review. In line with Department for Education guidance, we are now starting to monitor attendance more rigorously and appreciate your continued support. Our current attendance for the whole school is 93.8% which is under the 96% threshold. We also have several children who arrive late everyday. If your child arrives after 9.30am this goes down as unauthorised absence. Please try to get to school on time, arriving late not only impacts your child's education but also impacts our lunch orders which have to be submitted by 9.30am at the latest. Our

late/absence procedures can be viewed on our website in the Parents tab. If your child is absent from school for any reason you must remember to ring the school office and let us know. Where possible, medical appointments should be made outside of school hours and we do need to see a copy of the appointment letter for our attendance records which are audited regularly.

The staff member will stay off for ten days which obviously puts a huge strain on support throughout the school but I am so proud of the team at Seven Stars who are working so hard to make school a happy, safe and caring place for everyone.

Year 6 visits to High Schools

At this time of year our Year 6s usually attend their chosen High School (this year it is meant to be on Friday 2nd July). However, following the announcement from the government of the restrictions being extended to 19th July, some of these visits are unlikely to take place. We will keep you informed but we will still do our best to organise transition preparation work for our Year 6 pupils within school (the High Schools have some very good information on their web-sites that parents and Year 6 pupils can access).

Mid-day supervisors

If anyone is interested in becoming a mid-day supervisor please get in touch with the school office.

You need to be someone with lots of patience, a love for children, willing to get involved in actively engaging with the children and have a very big smile!

(Male or female of any age from 17 upwards - subject to DBS safeguarding checks and there will be a mini-interview).

Sports Days

Due to the increase in infections in the area we will not be opening up our Sports Days or any other events to parents this year. It is upsetting but we must put the safety of our community first.

We will however do our very best to record as many events as we can so you can see them on Class Dojo and Facebook.
